DOST-2019 Phase-I Press Conference Note on 10.06.2019

- Total number of students registered in DOST-2019, Phase-I: 1,21,363
- Total number of students who exercised web options in DOST-2019 Phase-I: 1,11,429
- Total number of students allotted in Phase-1: 1,05,433
- Total number of students who got seat allotment against first priority of their web options: 75,184
- Total number of students who got seat allotment against second or other priority: 30,459
- Total number of students allotted in Government Degree Colleges within the opted district and course: 424
- Total number of students who exercised web options but could not get seat allotment due to insufficient web options: 5996
- Total allotment, Gender wise - male: 40,375 (38.3%), female: 65,058 (61.7%), Total: 105433
- Total intake for Phase -1: 3,83,514
- Total Allotted seats: 1,05,433
- Total vacancies after Phase -1: 2,78,081
- Instructions to the Students:
 - The students who got seat allotment will receive SMS regarding their seat allotments
 - The student who got seat allotment shall report online only (Online Self Reporting) by paying Online Rs.1000/- or Rs.500/- as the case may be. This student can exercise web options for better seat going for sliding
 - The student is not required to report to the college immediately. The student shall report to the college only on 01.07.2019

- If the student fails to confirm the seat online (Online Self Reporting), he/she will forego the seat allotted in the respective Phase, and has to exercise the web options freshly
- The registrations and web options for Phase-II shall start from 10.06.2019 and the last date is 15.06.2019
