Faculty Development Program for the French Language teachers

To create global employment and education opportunities for the students of Telangana, Telangana State Council of Higher Education has decided to revise the French as a Second language syllabus and launched a uniform syllabus for all the state universities drafted as per the Common European Framework for Reference for languages.

In order to upskill the French language teachers on the revised syllabus and the pedagogical tools to be used, Chairman, TSCHE convened a 2 day workshop scheduled on 27th and 28th September, 2022 at Osmania University College of Arts and Social Sciences.

The workshop is jointly organised by TSWREIS, Osmania University in partnership with Alliance Francaise, Hyderabad.

The sessions will focus on different components of French language teaching delivered by experts from Alliance Francaise, EFLU and Osmania University. A special webinar from the author of the Cosmopolite book is also included. Delegates from the Government of Telangana, State Universities, French Consulate in Bangalore and French Industry in Telangana will be gracing the occasion.
